Resilience and the Benefits of Art

COVID 19 has impacted our communities in ways we still cannot fully understand. Being isolated from our usual support systems and networks stressed us all, but especially strained those who were already isolated by issues of mental or physical health, or disabilities. The Momentum Art program provides a community for individuals to develop critical connections that build resilience while also learning creative self expression.

Art is a universal language. Art has the power to make us feel desperately alone or infinitely connected. It has the ability to reach across distance and time, across perspective and experience. Art tells a story and through these stories it builds understanding and community. The Momentum program helps artists use art to find their voices and share their stories.

Employment and Self Sufficiency

At Momentum, we support our artists to become 'work-ready' by working on social and professional interactions, building confidence, and honing skills appropriate for a workplace environment. Arists that are ready to further their artistic careers are able to take an art professionalism and entrepreneur track that includes gallery and art promotion opportunities, and training on how to network with other artists, promote and sell their work, and how to use their work to become self-sufficient.

Alex F. is an artist that has been attending Momentum for several years after being reintroduced to the art world by a CSA worker. "Momentum has allowed me to create art that I normally wouldn't be able to make in my home. It gives me a place that I can go to relieve stress and anxiety. Coming to Momentum has given me the confidence to share how I'm feeling through art, make new friends, and even learn how to sell my paintings. Momentum has benefited my relationships with my service providers and with my family by allowing me to cope with my disability and learn how to communicate better. I can't say enough good things about the program."

"When I come here I am able to be free, I'm able to be me. [Momentum] makes a person feel like this is the place to be, this is where I want to be. 
